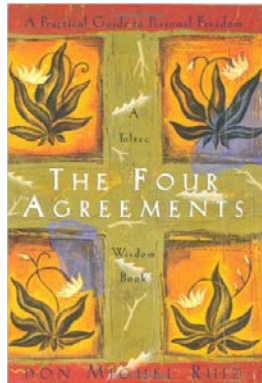

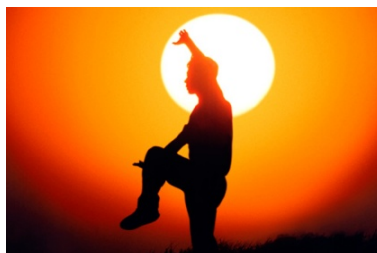

What other religious events or holidays are going on in November?

November 1...Birth of the Bab-Bahai (Bahai) The roots of the Bahai faith which emphasizes the spiritual unity of all humankind.



November 1...All Saints Day (Christian) A call to live as saints, to remind us how we are supposed to live.



November 1... Samhain - Beltane (Wicca/Pagan) A Gaelic festival marking the end of the harvest season and the beginning of winter or the "darker half" of the year.



November 2... All Souls Day (Christian) Long ago in Ireland and Britain, Christians would come together on All Hallows Eve to ask for God's blessing and protection from the evil in the world.



November 11...Veterans Day (USA) A national ceremony is held each year at Arlington Cemetery to honor and thank all who served in the United States Armed Forces.

November 14... Birthday of Guru Nanak (Sikh) Guru Nanak was one of the greatest religious innovators of all time and founder of the Sikh religion.



November 15... Shichigosan (Japan) Is a rite of passage in Japan for children. It's a day to wish for their health and happiness.



November 23... Niinamesei (Japan) the Great Festival of Thanksgiving. A national holiday in Japan celebrated with a harvest festival.



November 24...Thanksgiving (USA, Canada) Is a national holiday celebrated as a day of giving thanks for the blessing of the harvest and of the preceding year.

November 25... Day of the Covenant (Bahai) Recognizes the overall concept of the covenant between God and humanity.
